Procedure for the elimination of hazardous substances from SF packaging materials

This document describes the procedure to avoid hazardous substances in our flexible packaging materials

Hazardous substances are identified by the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) and published twice a year in the SVHC-list, which is part of the REACH-regulation ((EU) 1907/2006). SVHC stands for Substances of Very High Concern.

RA-specialists at the different SF-sites are obliged twice a year (normally in January and July, after new editions of the SVHC-lists had been published) to demand compliance-confirmations from their suppliers with the actual SVHC-list. In case of non-compliance, the corresponding raw material has to be eliminated from the recipe.

As well there is a company statement from Group Head RA explaining a) the scope of REACH for Schur Flexibles and b) the way of respecting the SVHC-list within Schur Flexibles.

This document and the written compliance-confirmation are given to customers on their request.
